


RoHS Certificate of Compliance

As to the Directive of 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and the Council of 8 June, 2011 on the restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, Custom Interconnects, operating in Centennial, Colorado USA, hereby declares that our products are in conformance. The RoHS directive became effective on July 21, 2011 and restricts the use of 10 substances, as listed below, within electrical and electronic equipment from the effective date forward.

Hazardous Substances as defined by the RoHS directive:

1. Lead (Pb)
2. Mercury (Hg)
3. Cadmium (Cd)
4. Hexavalent chromium (Cr)
5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
7. Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
8. Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

Custom Interconnects certifies that to the best of our knowledge and based on the information available, our products comply with the maximum allowable concentrations of these substances.
